ASSESSMENT CRITERIA:

Students will be assessed on their ability to demonstrate the following:

- Memorisation of Juz' 29 for Senior students
- Memorisation of Juz' 30 for Junior students
- Correct Pronunciation
- Use of vocal rhythmic modes (Qur'anic Maqamat) in recitation

Prizes will be awarded according to a point system where:

- First prize winner will need to score 95 or more points out of 100
- Second prize winner will need to score 85 points or more out of 100
- Third prize winner will need to score 75 points or more out of 100
