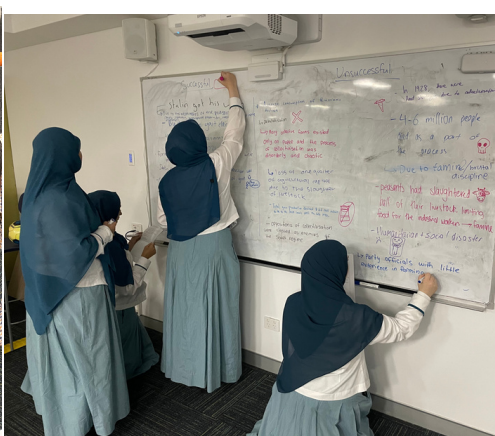
DEPUTY HEAD OF SENIOR SCHOOL

Congratulations to the Year 7 and Year 9 students on their attitude and effort with NAPLAN testing over the last two weeks. These national tests provide detailed data on individual students and their progress, as well as providing comparisons to other similar schools. The data provides useful information for teachers about student progress in literacy and numeracy and helps guide our strategic and academic intent to nurture growth and enhance teaching and learning reform.

Over the last few weeks, our staff have been engaged in developing programs and strategies that are designed to inspire and support student growth and deepen their understanding in subject specific areas. As our community grows and develops, our staff have supported one another in building upon the foundations already established, and enhancing their skills as effective practitioners in their fields of expertise. Professional development, team teaching and meetings are focused on key areas such as direct and explicit instructions, learning frameworks and visible thinking routines and their effectiveness as learning tools within the classroom.

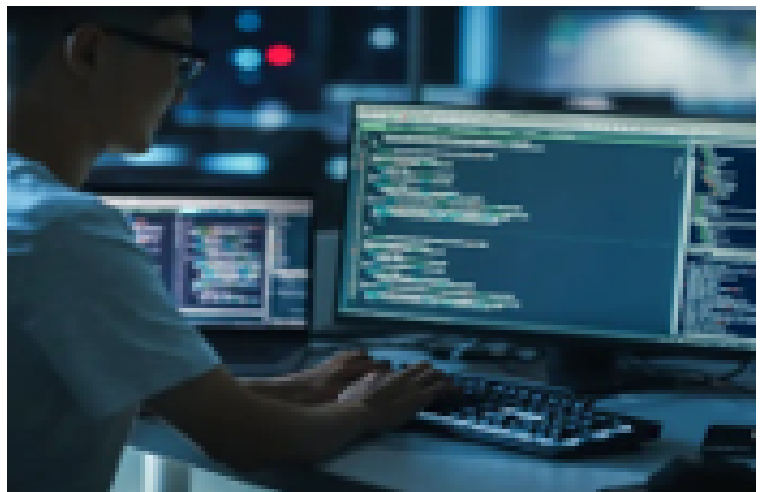
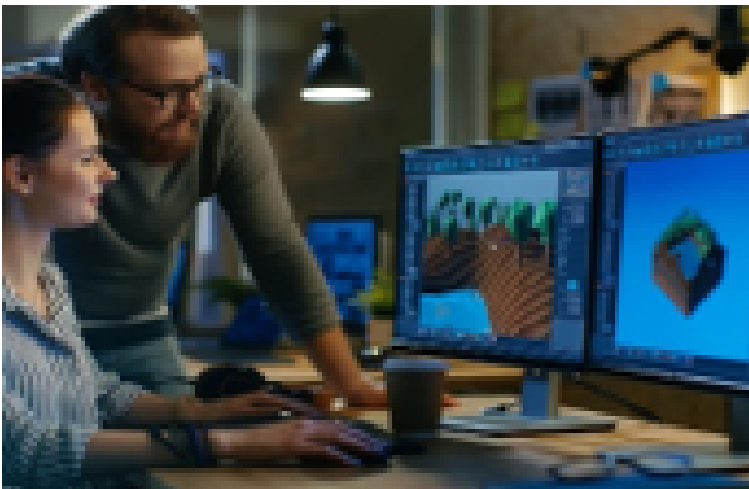
