Dear Parents and Bellfield Community,

Year 7 camp is behind us now and I am pleased to report that it was a great success and I express my gratitude for your support.

The camp provided our students with a unique opportunity to develop their independence, resilience, and teamwork skills. They were able to participate in a range of activities, including rock climbing, hiking, and more. These activities allowed our students to challenge themselves physically and spiritually in a safe and supportive environment.




In addition to the outdoor activities, our students also had the chance to connect with one another in a way that is not possible in a traditional classroom setting. They formed new friendships and strengthened existing ones, and they learned to work together as a team to overcome challenges.

They encountered unique challenges related to tahara (ritual purity) and prayer that are not commonly found in our daily life. These challenges included navigating bathroom facilities, properly removing najasah (ritual impurity) during wudu (ablution) or tayammum (dry ritual purification), determining the direction of prayer, and identifying appropriate prayer items.

I am particularly proud of how well our students adapted to the camp environment. Many of them were away from home for the first time, and they showed great maturity and independence throughout the trip. They also learned valuable life skills, such as how to make their beds, keep their living areas clean, and manage their time effectively.

Overall, I believe that the Year 7 camp was an incredibly valuable experience for our students, and I hope that it has left a lasting impression on them. I want to thank you again for your support and for entrusting us with your child's education. It is a privilege to work with such wonderful young people.

cash/envelope ordering

Your school prefers orders to be placed online. However, if you are unable to order online, please complete your order using the order envelope provided.

STEP 1

Complete a separate order envelope for each individual child's package/s ordered. If ordering for more than one child, payment should be enclosed in the envelope of the eldest child and this should be indicated on the envelope of the other child/children (the envelope that does not have cash enclosed).

STEP 2

Enclose exact cash payment in one envelope for the package/s you are ordering. Payment for more than one child should be in the eldest child's envelope and marked at the bottom of the envelope in the space provided.

STEP 3

Return your completed envelope/s, with correct cash payment, to our photographers on the day.

Please note: You must enclose exact correct payment, as change is not available. Credit card payments can only be made online and we no longer accept cheques. There is a separate envelope for sibling photo orders, should your school choose to offer sibling photos.

School photographs will be returned approximately 6 weeks after the day of photography. Please note this delivery timeframe is dependent on proofing and additional photography days at your school.

IMPORTANT - "not for publication" students

If you have instructed your school that your child's image is "not for publication" (sometimes called "do not publish" or "not for media release" instructions), the school will ensure that your child is not presented to our photographers on photo day and school photographs will not be available for purchase. If you wish to change your instruction, then you must notify your school, so they change their records and identify your child as able to be photographed for school photography purposes. All students presented to our photographers by your school on photo day will be photographed, their images will appear in school photography packages with their fellow students and these packages will be available to purchase by all families.

Uniform Supply Issues

We regret to inform you that the new sport uniform pants are out of stock with a considerable wait time for purchase (May 2023). In the meantime, we ask that students without the correct sport pants wear plain black track pants. These can be purchased from Kmart, Best & Less or Big W. Students must have evidence of an order when asked by a teacher.



BOYS HAIRCUT

Students are required to wear their hair in a neat and tidy manner. Haircuts should be of an even grade. Hair should be well brushed and combed and it is assumed that hair will not be in such a condition as to invite comment.

Please be aware of the following:

- Extreme styles of hair are not permitted.
- Gel, mousse and hair spray or other similar substances should not be used.
- There will be no undercuts or steps.
- Nothing shorter than a number 4 comb is acceptable.
- Hair should not touch the shirt collar.
- Beards should be always well groomed / or clean shaven.
- Long sideburns are not permitted.
- Students will not attend class and parents will called to collect their child from school.
- Students who do not abide by the haircut requirements will be asked to fix the identified problem and not return to school until the issue is resolved.

Regular hair blitzs will enforce these expectations.



Jewellery Reminder
